AMADOR COUNTY SUPERIOR COURT APPOINTS NEW .3 AB 1058 CHILD SUPPORT COMMISSIONER/ RESEARCH ATTORNEY

We are pleased to announce the appointment of Renee Day to the part-time AB 1058 Child Support Commissioner position. In addition to this appointment, Ms. Day will also serve as the Court's Research Attorney. She will start her new assignment January 6, 2014.

The AB 1058 Child Support Commissioner will primarily hear support and contempt matters brought by Central Sierra Child Support Agency as part of the Title IV-D child support enforcement program, and may assist with other matters, as assigned by the Presiding Judge. This program is funded through a cooperative agreement between the California Department of Child Support Services (DCSS) and the Judicial Council. Each local court is required to have a child support commissioner to hear cases brought by the local child support agency.

In her role as the Court's research attorney, Ms. Day will oversee a wide range of legal services and advise Judicial Officers, the Court Executive Officer and staff on a wide range of legal matters.

Ms. Day received her Juris Doctorate from the University of San Diego School of Law. She has spent the bulk of her career in family law litigation, and recently as Court Appointed Counsel for parents and/or children in juvenile dependency matters. Most of her law career has been spent in private practice with law firms in San Jose, California.
