**THE COURT IS CLOSED UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE, EXCEPT FOR THE FOLLOWING:**

- Effective March 23<sup>rd</sup>, the Court will be conducting hearings for the following matters only:

Criminal In-Custody Hearings  
No Time Waivers  
Juvenile Detentions  
Emergency Guardianships  
Emergency Protective Orders  
Emergency Custody Orders

All other hearings will be suspended until further notice. For all other matters, the Court will be sending you notice of your new hearing date.

- Effective March 19<sup>th</sup>, the Court will be receiving filings for the following matters between 9:30 am and 3:00 pm only:

Requests for Restraining Orders  
Emergency Custody Orders  
Dependency Petitions  
Delinquency Petitions  
Emergency Guardianships  
Criminal (As it relates to the above criminal hearings)

All other filings will be suspended until further notice.

Effective immediately, the Court has suspended all jury trials until further notice.
