

AUGUST 17, 2006 CASE MANAGEMENT CONFERENCE TENTATIVE RULINGS

To request a hearing on any matter on this calendar, you must call the Court at (209) 223-6360 by 4:00 p.m. today. Notice of the intention to appear must also be given to all other parties. If the clerk is not notified of a party's intention to appear, there will be no hearing and the tentative ruling will become the order of the court.

Armstrong v. State of California: 05CV3994

This matter is hereby referred to arbitration.

In addition, this matter is set for a 12-day jury trial, commencing on May 8, 2007 at 9:00 a.m. in Department 2. A Mandatory Settlement Conference is scheduled for April 6, 2007 at 8:30 a.m. in Department 2.

Erhart v. Billington: 06CV4113

The Court notes that neither party filed a timely Case Management Conference Statement. Should any subsequent violation of Local Rule 8.05 occur, the Court will set this matter for an Order to Show Cause and sanctions may be imposed.

This matter is hereby referred to arbitration.

In addition, this matter is set for a 5-day jury trial, commencing on March 13, 2007 at 9:00 a.m. in Department 2. A Mandatory Settlement Conference is scheduled for February 16, 2007 at 8:30 a.m. in Department 2.

Pursuant to the parties' agreement, discovery will remain open until 30 days before trial.

Ford Motor Credit Co. v. Gutierrez: 06CV4114

The Court notes that the plaintiff failed to file a timely Case Management Conference Statement. Should any subsequent violation of Local Rule 8.05 occur, the Court will set this matter for an Order to Show Cause and sanctions may be imposed.

This matter is not yet at issue as to Defendant Raul Gutierrez. Plaintiff is ordered to serve this defendant by the next Case Management Conference. Defendant Milo Gutierrez was served on March 29, 2006. No answer has been filed by Defendant Milo Gutierrez. To date, Plaintiff has failed to submit a request for default judgment as to Defendant Milo Gutierrez.

This Case Management Conference is continued to October 19, 2006 at 10:00 a.m. in Department 2. Plaintiff is ordered to give notice of this Case Management Conference at the time of service on Defendant Raul Gutierrez. Plaintiff is ordered to give notice of said Conference to Defendant Milo Gutierrez if he appears. If he does not appear, Plaintiff should have a default judgment on file prior to the next Case Management Conference.

New Case Management Conference Statements, in compliance with Local Rule 8.05, are required.

Friddle v. Campbell: 06CV4238

The Court notes that the plaintiff failed to submit a timely Case Management Conference Statement. Should any subsequent violations of Local Rule 8.05 occur, the Court will set this matter for an Order to Show Cause and sanctions may be imposed.

This matter is continued to November 16, 2006 at 10:00 a.m. in Department 2. The parties should be prepared to discuss ADR and set a trial date at the time of the next Case Management Conference.

New Case Management Conference Statements, in compliance with Rule 8.05, are required.

Gorremans v. Joe Opie Trucking: 05CV4059

The Court notes that the plaintiff failed to file a timely Case Management Conference Statement. Should any subsequent violations of Local Rule 8.05 occur, the Court will set this matter for an Order to Show Cause and sanctions may be imposed.

This matter is continued to September 21, 2006 at 9:00 a.m. in Department 2. The parties should be prepared to set a trial date at the time of the next Case Management Conference.

This matter is continued to October 19, 2006 at 10:00 a.m. in Department 2. If the defendant appears, the plaintiff is ordered to give notice of the Further Case Management Conference.

New Case Management Conference Statements, in compliance with Rule 8.05, are required.

Notion Marketing Corp. v. Creative Crafts: 06CV4247

The Court received the plaintiff's request for default judgment. Therefore, the instant Case Management Conference is dropped from calendar.

Real Time Resolutions, Inc. v. Ricketts: 06CV4240

The Court notes that the plaintiff failed to file a timely Case Management Conference Statement and the defendant failed to file a Case Management Conference Statement. Should any subsequent violations of Local Rule 8.05 occur, the Court will set this matter for an Order to Show Cause and sanctions may be imposed.

Should any subsequent violations of Local Rule 8.05 occur, the Court will set this matter for an Order to Show Cause and sanctions may be imposed.

Ford Motor Credit Co. v. Smith: 06CV4061

This matter is continued to October 5, 2006 at 10:00 a.m. in Department 2. Plaintiff is ordered to have service on all defendants completed at the time of the next Case Management Conference. Plaintiff is further ordered to give notice of the further Case Management Conference at the time of service.

New Case Management Conference Statements, in compliance with Rule 8.05, are required.

Ide v. Ford Motor Co.: 05CV3734

There is no tentative ruling in this matter. Both parties are ordered to appear for Trial Setting.

Unifund CCR Partners v. Niebauer: 05CV4022

Neither party submitted a Case Management Conference Statement in compliance with Local Rule 8.05. As this is the second time that the parties have failed to comply with Local Rule 8.05, this matter is hereby set for an Order to Show Cause and Further Case Management Conference. The Clerk will provide notice of the date and time for said hearing.

Wilburn v. Estate of Rodrigues: 05CV4100

The Court notes that Defendant Tony Rodrigues failed to file a timely Case Management Conference Statement. Should any subsequent violations of Local Rule 8.05 occur, the Court will set this matter for an Order to Show Cause and sanctions may be imposed.
