Ballesteros v. Carter: 06CV4153

Plaintiff failed to comply with Local Rule 8.05. As this is the second violation of Rule 8.05, this matter is hereby set for an Order to Show Cause and Further Case Management Conference on November 30, 2006 at 3:15 p.m. in Department 2. The Court will provide formal notice of said hearing. The parties should be prepared to set a trial date at the next hearing.

Fancher v. Greiner: 06CV4335
