To request a hearing on any matter on this calendar, you must call the Court at (209) 223-6360 by 4:00 p.m. today. Notice of the intention to appear must also be given to all other parties. If the clerk is not notified of a party's intention to appear, there will be no hearing and the tentative ruling will become the order of the court.

Amodo v. Kesler: 05CV4088

Neither party complied with Local Rule 8.05. As the parties have failed to comply with Rule 8.05 on multiple occasions, the Court hereby sets this matter for an Order to Show Cause and Further Case Management Conference on February 22, 2007 at 3:15 p.m. in Department 2. The Clerk will provide formal notice of said hearing.

CB Merchant Services v. Castorena: 06CV4419

Defendant failed to comply with Local Rule 8.05. Should there be any further violations of Local Rule 8.05, the Court will set this matter for an Order to Show Cause and sanctions may be imposed.

This matter is continued to April 5, 2007 at 10:00 a.m. in Department 2. The parties should be prepared to set a trial date at that time.
