If the clerk is not notified of a party's intention to appear, there will be no hearing and the tentative ruling will become the order of the court.

Brown v. City of Amador: 05CV4012

Defendants City of Amador and Kenneth McDonald failed to comply with Local Rule 8.05. Should any further violations of Rule 8.05 occur, the Court will set this matter for an Order to Show Cause and sanctions may be imposed.

All parties are to appear, either telephonically or personally, for a Trial Setting Conference.

Central Valley Partners in Care v. Meeker: 06CV4466
