To request a hearing on any matter on this calendar, you must call the Court at (209) 223-6360 by 4:00 p.m. today. Notice of the intention to appear must also be given to all other parties. If the clerk is not notified of a party's intention to appear, there will be no hearing and the tentative ruling will become the order of the court.

People of the State of California v. Bowman: 06CV4461

This matter is continued to August 2, 2007 at 10:00 a.m. in Department 2. The parties should be prepared to provide an update regarding the status of the related criminal matter at that time.

New Case Management Conference Statements, in compliance with Local Rule 8.05, are required.

Fancher v. Greiner: 06CV4335

This matter is referred to arbitration. Discovery will remain open until 30 days before trial.

This matter is set for a 5-day jury trial, commencing on September 18, 2007 at 9:00 a.m. in Department 2. A mandatory settlement conference is scheduled for August 17, 2007 at 8:30 a.m. in Department 2.

This matter is scheduled for a 4-day jury trial, commencing on September 25, 2007 at 9:00 a.m. in Department 2. This matter is set for a Mandatory Settlement Conference on August 24, 2007 at 8:30 a.m. in Department 2.

CB Merchant Services v. Foyil: 06CV4448

All parties are ordered to appear, either personally or telephonically, for the purposes of trial setting.

Hunt v. Herrick: 06CV4520
