

**APRIL 5, 2007 CASE MANAGEMENT CONFERENCE TENTATIVE RULINGS**

**To request a hearing on any matter on this calendar, you must call the Court at (209) 223-6360 by 4:00 p.m. today. Notice of the intention to appear must also be given to all other parties. If the clerk is not notified of a party's intention to appear, there will be no hearing and the tentative ruling will become the order of the court.**

**California Dept. of Forestry & Fire Protection v. Pacific Gas & Electric: 06CV4436**

Plaintiff failed to comply with Rule 8.05. As this is the second violation of Rule 8.05, this matter is set for an Order to Show Cause and Further Case Management Conference on June 1, 2007 at 10:00 a.m. in Department 2. The Court will provide formal notice of the same.

**Faust v. Kellerman: 06CV4436**

Neither party complied with Local Rule 8.05. As this is the second violation of Rule 8.05 by the plaintiff, this matter is set for an Order to Show Cause and Further Case Management Conference on June 1, 2007 at 10:00 a.m. in Department 2. The Court will provide formal notice of the same.

**CB Merchant Services v. Castorena: 06CV4419**
