CACH, LLC V. Gomez: 06CV4511

This matter is continued to November 30, 2007 at 10:00 a.m. If the plaintiff has not obtained a default judgment by said date, this matter will be set for an Order to Show Cause and sanctions may be imposed.

American Tile & Brick Veneer, Inc. v. County of Amador: 07CV4782
