If the clerk is not notified of a party's intention to appear, there will be no hearing and the tentative ruling will become the order of the court.

21ST Century Insurance Co. v. Desaigoudar: 07CV4788

This matter is continued to May 12, 2008 at 1:30 p.m. in Department 2. Plaintiff is to have defendant served or an order for service by publication obtained prior to the next hearing. Plaintiff is to provide notice of the continued hearing at the time of service.

New case management conference statements, in compliance with Rule 8.05, are required.

All Points Custom Capitol v. Cook Custom Cabinetry: 07CV4973

Plaintiff failed to comply with Local Rule 8.05. As this is the second violation of Rule 8.05, this matter is set for an order to show cause and further case management conference on April 25, 2008 at 10:00 a.m. in Department 2. The Court will provide notice of the hearing.
