IF THE CLERK IS NOT NOTIFIED OF A PARTY'S INTENTION TO APPEAR, THERE WILL BE NO HEARING AND THE TENTATIVE RULING WILL BECOME THE ORDER OF THE COURT. NO FURTHER NOTICE OF THE COURT'S RULING WILL BE PROVIDED.

ATLANTIC CREDIT AND FINANCE, INC. V. FERRETTI: 08CV5348

This matter is continued to October 20, 2008 at 10:00 a.m. in Department 3. If Plaintiff has not served defendant or obtained an order for service by publication prior to the next hearing, this matter will be set for an order to show cause and sanctions may be imposed. Plaintiff is to provide notice of the continued hearing at the time of service.
