IF THE CLERK IS NOT NOTIFIED OF A PARTY'S INTENTION TO APPEAR, THERE WILL BE NO HEARING AND THE TENTATIVE RULING WILL BECOME THE ORDER OF THE COURT. NO FURTHER NOTICE OF THE COURT'S RULING WILL BE PROVIDED.

AMADOR MECHANICAL V. MEAGHER: 08CV5235

This matter is continued to March 16, 2009 at 10:00 a.m. in Department 3.

New case management conference statements, in compliance with Rule 8.05, are required.

BONNEAU V. ALBERTA HALE LAND TRUST: 08CV5182

This matter is continued to March 16, 2009 at 9:00 a.m. in Department 3.

Plaintiffs have not filed a proof of service as to Defendant Alberta Hale Land Trust. Plaintiffs' case management conference states said party has been served, but has not yet appeared. If said defendant has in fact been served, the defendant should have its default taken prior to the next hearing.

CITY OF PLYMOUTH V. PACIFIC BELL: 08CV5349

sanctions may be imposed. Plaintiff is to provide notice of the continued hearing at the time of service.

New case management conference statements, in compliance with Rule 8.05, are required.

MERRILL LYNCH BANK V. LEATHERMAN: 08CV5393

Plaintiff failed to comply with CRC 3.740 (e) Therefore, this matter is set for an order to show cause and further case management conference on January 2, 2009 at 10:00 a.m. in Department 2. The court will provide notice of the hearing.

NEVILLE V. COUNTY OF AMADOR: 07CV4947

Neither party complied with Local Rule 8.05. Should there be any further violations of Rule 8.05, this matter will be set for an order to show cause and sanctions may be imposed.

This matter is continued to March 16, 2009 at 10:00 a.m. in Department 3. If a dismissal is on file prior to the next hearing, the matter will be dropped from calendar.

POOR V. KERNER: 06CV4535

Plaintiff failed to comply with Local Rule 8.05. Should there be any further violations of Rule 8.05, this matter will be set for an order to show cause and sanctions may be imposed.

The proof of service of Nikki Kerner is defective. Plaintiff failed to submit a corrected proof of service as directed in the prior tentative ruling. PROGRESSIVE WEST V. BOYD: 07CV5102

If the court is not notified of the selected mediator within 10 days, the court will appoint a panel mediator.

Defendant Isla Gipson requests a jury trial. This matter is set for a 5-day jury trial, commencing on February 10, 2009 at 9:00 a.m. in Department 2. This matter is set for a mandatory settlement conference on January 9, 2009 at 8:30 a.m. in Department 2.

ULM V. LANE: 08CV5388

Defendant failed to comply with Local Rule 8.05. Should there be any further violations of Rule 8.05, this matter will be set for an order to show cause and sanctions may be imposed.

This matter is hereby referred to arbitration. Discovery will remain open until 30 days before trial.

This matter is set for a 1-day Court trial, commencing on April 28, 2009 at 9:00 a.m. in Department 2. This matter is set for a mandatory settlement conference on March 20, 2009 at 8:30 a.m. in Department 2.

UNIFUND CCR V. WALLACE: 08CV5362

Plaintiff failed to comply with CRC 3.740 (f). Therefore, this matter is set for an order to show cause and further case management conference on January 9, 2009 at 10:00 a.m. in Department 2. The court will provide notice of the hearing.

WORLDWIDE ASSET PURCHASING II V. MASSI: 08CV5286

There is no tentative ruling in this matter, pursuant to Local Rule 8.05 (F).

JACKSON V. NORTON: 07CV4907

This matter is re-designated Track III.

This matter is continued to March 16, 2009 at 10:00 a.m. in Department 3. Plaintiff is to have defendant Norton served prior to the next hearing or an order to show cause will issue.

New case management conference statements, in compliance with Rule 8.05, are required.

MULLINS V. STATE OF CALIFORNIA: 07CV5014

As the parties represent they are participating in mediation, the court will not refer this to matter to ADR.

This matter is set for a 7-day jury trial, commencing on May 12, 2009 at 9:00 a.m. in Department 2. This matter is set for a mandatory settlement conference on April 10, 2009 at 8:30 a.m. in Department 2.

STATE FARM INSURANCE V. BREN'S CARE: 07CV5062

Neither party complied with Local Rule 8.05. Should there be any further violations of Rule 8.05, this matter will be set for an order to show cause and sanctions may be imposed.

This matter is continued to March 16, 2009 at 10:00 a.m. in Department 2. Plaintiff is to provide notice of the continued hearing if the defendant appears.

New case management conference statements, in compliance with Rule 8.05, are required.

STATE FARM INSURANCE V. WERTENBERGER: 08CV5310

Plaintiff failed to comply with Local Rule 8.05. Should there be any further violations of Rule 8.05, this matter will be set for an order to show cause and sanctions may be imposed.

Plaintiff has failed to serve the defendant in the time required by CRC 3.110. Therefore, this matter is set for an order to show cause, pursuant to CRC 3.110 (f), and further case management conference on January 9, 2009 at 10:00 a.m. in Department 2. The court will provide notice of the hearing.

SURETY COMPANY OF THE PACIFIC V. TALL PINES & Co.: 07CV5079

Plaintiff failed to comply with Local Rule 8.05. Should there be any further violations of Rule 8.05, this matter will be set for an order to show cause and sanctions may be imposed.

Neither party demanded a jury trial. This matter is set for a 3-day Court trial, commencing on April 14, 2009 at 9:00 a.m. in Department 2. This matter is set for a mandatory settlement conference on March 20, 2009 at 8:30 a.m. in Department 2.

GOLDEN ONE CREDIT UNION V. DAVIES: 08CV5243

Plaintiff has failed to serve the defendant in the time required by CRC 3.110. Therefore, this matter is set for an order to show cause, pursuant to CRC 3.110 (f), and further case management conference on January 9, 2009 at 10:00 a.m. in Department 2. The court will provide notice of the hearing.

GOLDEN ONE CREDIT UNION V. COE: 08CV5244

Plaintiff has failed to serve the defendant in the time required by CRC 3.110. Therefore, this matter is set for an order to show cause, pursuant to CRC 3.110 (f), and further case management conference on January 9, 2009 at 10:00 a.m. in Department 2. The court will provide notice of the hearing.

THE SIGN SHOP V. READE: 08CV5264

Plaintiff failed to comply with Local Rule 8.05. Should there be any further violations of Rule 8.05, this matter will be set for an order to show cause and sanctions may be imposed.

Plaintiff has failed to serve the proper defendant in the time required by CRC 3.110. Therefore, this matter is set for an order to show cause, pursuant to CRC 3.110 (f), and further case management conference on January 16, 2009 at 10:00 a.m. in Department 2. The court will provide notice of the hearing.

WELLS FARGO BANK V. HENDERSON: 08CV5279

Defendant failed to comply with Local Rule 8.05. Should there be any further violations of Rule 8.05, this matter will be set for an order to show cause and sanctions may be imposed.

This matter is set for a 2-hour Court trial on March 3, 2009 at 9:00 a.m. in Department 2. This matter is set for a mandatory settlement conference on February 13, 2009 at 8:30 a.m. in Department 2.
