Portfolio Recovery Associates, LLC v. Kenneth Uselton: 05CV3750

Order to Show Cause for Failure to Appear at Case Management Conference

There is no tentative ruling in this matter. Personal appearance by Defendant Kenneth Uselton is required. All other parties may appear by Courtcall.

Bonneau v. Bonneau: 02CV2461

Plaintiffs' Motion to Confirm Referee's Final Report

The Court notes that the Referee's Final report appears equitable and competent. There are no errors on the face of the report, which would require modification or disapproval of said report. However, Defendant alleges that he made improvements to the Indian Hill property and, accordingly, he should be awarded said property pursuant to Code of Civil Procedure Section 873,220. Unfortunately, Defendant has failed to support his Opposition with any evidence.

Accordingly, the Court will entertain oral argument on this issue prior to issuing a ruling. In order to accommodate the time necessary for a hearing on this matter, oral argument is set for Tuesday, October 11, 2005 at 3 p.m. in Department 2.
