

**JANUARY 26, 2007 FAMILY LAW CASE MANAGEMENT CONFERENCE TENTATIVE
RULINGS**

If the clerk is not notified of a party's intention to appear, there will be no hearing and the tentative ruling will become the order of the court.

Ballesteros v. Ballesteros: 06FC2944

Petitioner failed to comply with Local Rule 13.23. Should any further violations of Local Rule 13.23 occur, this matter will be set for an Order to Show Cause and sanctions may be imposed.

This matter is continued to April 27, 2007 at 9:00 a.m. in Department 2. The petitioner should have service completed by the date of the next Case Management Conference. At the time of service, Petitioner is to give notice of the continued Case Management Conference to the respondent.

Ortiz v. Ortiz: 06FC2930

The court referred this matter to mediation at the last Case Management Conference. Neither party appeared for the mediation scheduled on January 8, 2007. In addition, the parties failed to file Case Management Conference Statements. This is the second time each party has violated Rule 13.23. Therefore, this matter is set for an Order to Show Cause for Failure to Appear at Mediation and Failure to Comply with Rule 13.23 and for a Further Case Management Conference on March 22, 2007 at 8:30 a.m. in Department 2.

Pearle v. Pearle: 06FC2933

Neither party complied with Local Rule 13.23. Should any further violations of Local Rule 13.23 occur, this matter will be set for an Order to Show Cause and sanctions may be imposed.

This matter is scheduled for child custody orientation on February 20, 2007 at 4:00 p.m. This matter is scheduled for child custody mediation on March 1, 2007 at 10:00 a.m.

This matter is scheduled for a Further Case Management Conference and Review After Mediation on March 22, 2007 at 8:30 a.m. in Department 2.
